To all involved in wheelchair dance classification!

Classification and reclassification in 2006

Please be informed about the following facts:

- All dancers who were classified in 2000 or earlier and want to start again in a competition, will be seen as **'new'** and will have to go through the classification procedure. (Permanent status can be given after 2 international classifications with the same result.)
- All dancers who were classified in 2001 must appear for **reclassification**.
 - All classified permanent in class 2 may come.
 - All classified permanent in class 1 **MUST** come, unless they start in class 2.
 - The classification officer can provide NPC's or national classifiers with a list of those dancers who are obliged to come for reclassification.
- All who come for classification or reclassification: please keep in mind the following **VERY IMPORTANT** facts:
 - Athletes must be under competition circumstances
 - Competition wheelchair
 - All straps and means of support to be used under competition
 - Changing these items without permission can lead to disqualification.
 - Athletes must bring an identification card or passport which states nationality, name and date of birth in English.
 - Athletes must bring medical papers which states the medical diagnosis in English.
 - Athletes must bring copies of classification cards of earlier classifications.
 - Athletes must bring an interpreter if they don't speak and understand some English (or at a national classification if they don't speak the language of the national classifier.)
